National Service Scheme (NSS) - Our college NSS team organizes blood donations, offers voluntary service in villages and district administration and helps in flood relief and disaster management. The NSS wing of SKCET showcases vibrant implementation of MHRD and AICTE initiatives such as Swachhata, Fit India Movement, One student-One Tree and Plastic Free campaign. The students of SKCET actively engage in the activities organised by the NSS towards corporate social responsibility.

The Institute of Indian Foundrymen – SKCET Student’s Chapter - The Institute of Indian Foundrymen – SKCET Students Chapter was established in 2014. The club organizes guest lectures, workshops, seminars and industrial visit to the students of mechanical engineering.
